This heraldic shield has the typical characteristics of heraldic shields used in the High Middle Ages (c. 12th to 14th centuries) - a triangular or V shape, a flat top and rounded sides that taper to a point. It is made of plywood, tightly covered with linen and painted by hand. The back of the shield, painted yellow, has two so-called shield cuffs (holding straps/arm loops) and a longer shoulder strap made of strong, sturdy leather, which are...
